Westminster School – Mini case study

Westminster School, London acquired a new science building in Smith's Square back in 1986, and has continually updated its laboratories over the years using the project management skills of London based Perfectair Ltd.

The work benches were manufactured from Trespa solid laminate and supported on powder coated steel support frames to ensure a long lasting quality finish.

Logistics Centre is top notch

Kinetic Concepts are delighted to have been involved in installing new state of the art equipment into the brand new facilities at the Logistics School, University of Hull, which has recently been completed. Kinetic were awarded the contract for the installation of the new laboratory facility, the reception counter and other ancilliary furniture.

The £20 million construction project which began in October 2006, includes a cutting-edge technology showcase area, a logistics resource centre and a highly advanced 'incubator space' for start up organisations.

The institute is the only dedicated facility of its kind in the North of England and brings together expertise from business and engineering, and is one of only a few dedicated centres of excellence for logistics in the world.

The main contractors were local construction company Houltons Ltd who have had to delicately balance the significant amount of construction work whilst working within a listed building. However they have still managed to deliver the facility on time and within budget.

The designs were developed by Leeds based architect company Farrell & Clarke. The project architect, Mr Peter Stebbings commented: "We were extremely pleased with the result of combining the new conceptual entrance area whilst maintaining the integrity and character of the Grade II listed buildings."

The laboratory furniture installed consisted of a cantilevered based system providing solid laminate worktops with removable underbench cupboards beneath to provide additional working space and a high degree of flexibility.

Lee Wilson, the Technical Project Engineer for the Institute, was also very pleased with the laboratory installation, which he felt provided a modern business like environment with a high degree of adaptability.
